Congratulations and welcome to the **Eleventh AKC National Agility Championship!** We are looking forward to an exciting event located at Eden Park Equestrian Complex in Sunbury, Ohio. This year we are excited to host this event once again as a stand-alone event on a dirt surface and we are pleased to have a record number of participants attending. Please be sure to stop by and visit the booths of our sponsors, Clean Run Productions LLC and J&J Dog Supplies at this event and thank them for their continued support. Remember that all agility equipment used for this event will be available for purchase at the show site at a reduced rate!

We are lucky to be able to offer all the activities in one location this year. Please join us during the exhibitor check-in process for a free **Welcome Reception** for exhibitors, on **Thursday, March 29<sup>th</sup>** from 5:00 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Various food stations with a wide variety of foods including dessert will be available for everyone to mingle and create or renew friendships with folks from all over the country. Additionally, on **Friday, March 30<sup>th</sup>** come enjoy the fun of **a good ole fashioned Ice Cream Social** during the afternoon of the AKC International State Team Tournament. This social function is free to exhibitors and will begin at approximately 5:00 p.m. Your check-in packet that you will receive at the event is filled with information about activities in the local area. These events should prove to be three fun-filled days with great competition!

Eden Park Equestrian Complex asks that you abide by the following facility regulations. For the safety of everyone, there is **no smoking** allowed in or around the horse arena and barns. Additionally, no dogs are allowed in the lake located on the property. Any violation of these facility regulations is grounds for misconduct.

There is a single road into and out of the complex. Doors will open at 3:00 p.m. on Thursday and there will be parking attendants located at the entrance beginning at 2:00 p.m. to direct you to the unloading zone for your designated area either in the barns for rented stalls, RV's, or in general crating. Pre-registration was required for all RV parking and stall rental at this event. Handicapped parking is available and to establish a pre-assigned space please contact Jerry McKenzie for details at [minimovers@fuse.net](mailto:minimovers@fuse.net).

A \$5.00 **parking fee** per day will be collected for Friday through Sunday parking so please plan accordingly. A three-day parking pass may be purchased at a reduced price of \$12.00 from the Information Table on Thursday at the time of check-in. Passes may also be purchased from the parking attendants on Friday morning. Admission tickets are not required for spectators at this event.

Remember if you bring an un-entered dog with you to this event, it must be **at least six months of age** to be allowed on the grounds. Due to the large entry and limited space, un-entered dogs will only be allowed in the facility if they can fit in the assigned crating area of an entered dog; either in the same crate or stacked on top of an entered dog's crate or in a pre-rented stall. No ex-pens will be allowed in the general crating area. Dogs may not be left overnight at these events.

The Columbus area weather this time of year averages with lows in the mid-30's in the morning and highs in the mid- to upper 50's during the day. However, record setting temps have been anywhere from the low teens in the morning to low 80's during the day!

The safety and security of all is of utmost importance to all of us. Security guards will be on the grounds for this event. Please keep valuables safely stowed out of sight in a secure location.

**Directions to the Veterinary Clinic:** Start from the Eden Park Equestrian Complex go South on Blayney Rd for 0.9 miles. Turn slight right onto N OH-61 and go 1.0 miles. Turn right onto US-36/OH-3 0.4 miles. Turn Right onto W. Cherry St/US-36/OH 37. Continue to follow 36/37 for 3.8 miles. Merge onto I-71 South 10.9 miles. Merge onto I-270 West (Dayton) 1.9 miles. Exit at the first exit, 23 South/N. High Street, go South toward Worthington - 1.1 miles. Turn left onto E. Wilson Bridge Rd (first intersection) - 0.7 miles. Arrive at Medvet Medical Center for Pets (approximately 15-20 minutes).

No early birds will be allowed in to set-up prior to the above schedule and only committee members will be allowed in the arena prior to 3:00 p.m. Exhibitors who did not provide a jump height card for their dog with their entry form **must** be measured prior to check-in or provide a copy of their jump height card. A special area will be set up for these exhibitors to be measured or to drop off their jump height card. Check your confirmation letter. If there is an "\*N" beside "Height", you must proceed to the special check-in area.

**NOTE - Directions to Site:** If looking up directions on Mapquest, it will direct you to travel a different way through back roads. The following directions are more direct via the interstate and should provide less traffic. Eden Park Equestrian Complex is located north of Columbus, in Delaware County, and is in the country, so don't be alarmed as you leave the city!

**Directions to the event site from Cincinnati:**

Take I-275 North toward I-71/Columbus. Merge onto I-71N via EXIT 49B toward Columbus (90.48 miles). Merge onto I-71N via EXIT 101A on the LEFT toward Cleveland (22.67 miles). Take the US-36/OH-37 exit, EXIT 131 toward Delaware/Sunbury (0.20 miles). Turn RIGHT onto US-36/OH-37 (3.69 miles). Turn LEFT onto US-36/OH-3 (0.43 miles). Turn LEFT onto N OH-61 (1.03 miles). Turn slight LEFT onto Blayney Rd (0.91 miles). Follow to Eden Park Equestrian Complex. Approximate time is 2 hours, 20 minutes.

**Directions to the event site from Columbus:**

Take I-71N to US-36/OH-37. Turn RIGHT (East) onto US-36/OH-37 and follow 4-5 miles to OH-3 (intersection with traffic light). Follow about 1 mile turn LEFT onto Blayney Rd. Follow to Eden Park Equestrian Complex on the left.
