By consenting to a kid's entry, all parents and guardians represent and warrant that any material submitted is original, has not been previously published or won an award, does not infringe upon the copyright or any other right or interest of any other person or organization, and that any rights to such material have not been granted previously to any other person or organization, nor does any third party have any interest in such materials. - ◆ Entries will be chosen by qualified judges based on originality, content, quality, and appeal.
- ◆ No purchase necessary to enter or win this contest.
- ◆ The total approximate retail value of the prize to be awarded each winner is \$23.95. Prize is not transferable or redeemable for cash. No substitution, transfer or cash equivalent of a prize by a winner is permitted. All applicable federal, state, local or other taxes are the sole responsibility of winner.
