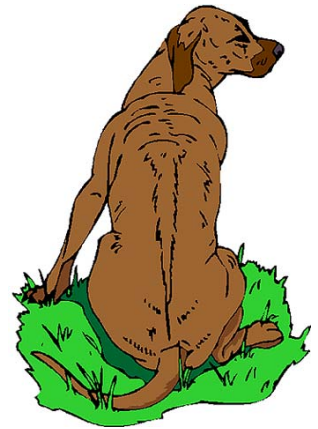


# Tail Tales

Whether it's long, short, bushy, or straight - there's no warmer welcome than a wagging tail! Specific terms describe different types of tails. Read the descriptions below and unscramble the names of the tails.

| 1. A curling tail, set high on the body, that forms a circle over the dog's back (Chow Chow)<br><i>CLUE: You may wear one of these on your finger.</i>                   | GINR<br>tail      |
| 2. A thick, tapered, blunt tail without feathering that hangs straight down (Labrador Retriever)<br><i>CLUE: Think of a small, brown animal that lives in the water.</i> | TEROT<br>tail     |
| 3. A bushy tail of long fringe that either hangs down or over the back (Pomeranian)<br><i>CLUE: This is another word for feather.</i>                                    | MEPLU<br>tail     |
| 4. A long, fringed tail (Golden Retriever)<br><i>CLUE: Birds can also be described this way.</i>   | THEEERADF<br>tail |
| 5. A thick, bushy tail that resembles a fox's (Newfoundland)<br><i>CLUE: If your hair is messy, you'll need one of these.</i>  | UBRSH<br>tail     |
| 6. A tail that has hair clipped to a round shape (Poodle)<br><i>CLUE: This word sounds like what cheerleaders use.</i>   | NOPMOP<br>tail    |
| 7. A small curled or kinked tail (Pug)<br><i>CLUE: You may need one of these to hold something together.</i>   | WRCSE<br>tail     |
| 8. A long short-coated tail that tapers to a point (Rhodesian Ridgeback)<br><i>CLUE: Part of this word was just used to describe this tail.</i>                          | GTANIPER<br>tail  |
| 9. A long thin tail (Great Dane)<br><i>CLUE: Indiana Jones carries one of these.</i>   | HWPI<br>tail      |
