Reminder:

The Board reviewed a Staff recommendation to allow an exception to the Conformation Junior Showmanship Regulations to allow Juniors to continue to compete beyond their 18th birthday up until their 19th birthday or December 31, 2021, whichever comes first. This was passed unanimously by the AKC Board. This is for Juniors who turned 18 on or after March 1, 2020.

Qualifying Dates are: October 8, 2020 - October 13, 2021.

Criteria includes 3 wins in Open with Competition as well as a 3.0 grade point average or equivalent. The Spring Semester is almost over, please go ahead and submit your transcript if you are planning to attend the AKC National Championship sponsored by Royal Canin in Orlando in December.
