The 2021 American Kennel Club Pointing Breed National Walking Gun Dog Championship began on March 4, 2021. 62 dogs were drawn to compete in the Nation's premier all breed National Walking Championship. Coats were shed early in the day as the temperature rose into the mid 70's by early afternoon. Winds remained light, under 10 MPH throughout the day.
