1. We have small entries at our Specialties. Do you have any suggestions on what is a reasonable compensation for both parties?

I recommend being up front with the club your working with to ensure that they can cover the cost and you work your breakdown based on overall success of both events. It should be a give and take. I would not recommend going below a \$3 fee for entry.

2. Is there a distance requirement for the creation of a new Performance Club? i.e. Can there be another club in the same city or geographic area?
