### **Breed Temperament**

One of the things that makes a specific breed of dog unique is not only the dog's physical appearance, but each breed also has its own distinct temperament.

Each AKC breed has a national parent club (see akc.org).

Parent clubs describe their breed's ideal temperament in the written breed standard.

A summary of the temperament (as per the parent club's breed standards for each breed) follows.

Where an asterisk (\*) appears, it indicates that there was not a specific section on temperament in the parent club's breed standard. The description in this guide for these breeds was based on information about the breed written by parent clubs.



# AKC Groups Part 1

AKC has grouped all of the breeds that it registers into 7 categories or groups.

These are: Sporting, Hound, Terrier, Working, Toy, Herding and Non-Sporting.

These groups are based on function and heritage. They share traits of form and function or a common heritage.

#### Sporting Group - Temperament as Described in AKC Breed Standard

<b>English Springer Spaniel</b>	Friendly, eager to please, willing to obey. Should not be timid or aggression (to people or dogs).
Field Spaniel	Sensitive, docile (willing), fun-loving, independent, intelligent. Should not be shy, fearful or aggressive.
Flat-Coated Retriever	Responsive, sensible, bright, confident, happy, outgoing. Should not be nervous, shy or aggressive.
<b>German Shorthaired Pointer</b>	Friendly, intelligent, willing-to-please; keen enthusiasm to work. Should not be nervous.
<b>German Wirehaired Pointer</b>	Affectionate, eager to please; at times aloof but not unfriendly towards strangers.
Golden Retriever	Friendly, reliable, trustworthy. Shouldn't be timid, nervous or quarrelsome toward people or other dogs.
Gordon Setter	Affectionate, alert, interested, confident; fearless, willing, intelligent.
Irish Red & White Setter	Kindly, friendly; determined, courageous, high-spirited.
Irish Setter	Outgoing stable temperament is the essence of the breed. Should not be shy or timid.
Irish Water Spaniel	Alert, inquisitive, active; stable; may be reserved with strangers; should not be aggressive or shy.
Labrador Retriever	Outgoing, intelligent, adaptable, eager to please, should not be aggressive or shy.
Lagotto Romagnolo	Affectionate, easy to train; good companion; excellent watchdog; should not be aggressive or shy.
Nederlandse Kooikerhondje	Cheerful, confident, good-natured, friendly with owners-may be reserved with strangers, attentive.
Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retriever	Intelligent, alert, but not nervous or hyperactive; affectionate, may be reserved but not shy.
Pointer	Loyal, hard-working, courageous. Even temperament, congenial companion; should not be timid.
Spinone Italiano	Naturally sociable, docile, affectionate, patient.
Sussex Spaniel	Friendly, cheerful, tractable (easy to deal with).
Vizsla	Lively, gentle, affectionate, sensitive but fearless with protective instincts; should not be shy, timid, or nervous.
Weimaraner	Friendly, fearless, alert, obedient.
Welsh Springer Spaniel	Active, affectionate; reserved with strangers, not timid or shy; not timid, shy or unfriendly; devoted family member.
Wirehaired Pointing Griffon	Friendly, intelligent; easily trained, outgoing, willing to please, trustworthy; excellent family dog.
Wirehaired Vizsla	Confident, sensitive, stubborn, affectionate with owner; can be aloof with strangers; keen protective instinct.

Part 2 of this guide includes the breed temperament descriptions for FSS (Foundation Stock Service) breeds. AKC created the FSS record-keeping service to allow rare breed fanciers to continue their commitment to the improvement of their breed.

FSS is a requirement for fanciers of a breed who want to achieve full AKC recognition. FSS breeds may compete in AKC Family Dog and Companion and Performance events that AKC determines to be applicable.
