

Word Problems for Adding with Regrouping

Use base ten blocks and a place value mat to solve these problems.

1. Mateo has 12 dog toys. Sofia gives him 14 more. How many dog toys does Mateo have now?
2. Mateo has 15 dog treats. Sofia gives him some more. Now Mateo has 23 dog treats. How many did Sofia give Mateo?
3. Mateo had some puppy treats. Sofia gave him 13 more. Now Mateo has 21 puppy treats. How many did he have at first?
4. Mateo has a ribbon that is 15 inches long. Sofia has a ribbon that is 9 inches long. How long are their ribbons together, when they place them end to end?
5. Sofia read *Henry and Mudge* to her dog for 22 minutes on Monday. Then she read some more on Tuesday. She wrote down 37 minutes of reading in her reading log. How much did she read on Tuesday?
6. Mateo walked his dog for a while on Saturday. He also walked his dog for 15 minutes on Sunday. If he walked a total of 31 minutes for both days, how long did he walk his dog on Saturday?
