<u>CHAPTER 3</u> Making Application to Hold a Field Trial	<u>CHAPTER 3</u> Making Application to Hold a Field Trial	This recommendation was first proposed by the Basset Hound Club of America.
SECTION 1. A club which wishes to hold a licensed or member field trial must apply to The American Kennel Club on a form which will be supplied on request to clubs that meet the requirements of The American Kennel Club. This application will be referred to the Board of Directors of The American Kennel Club which will consider it and notify the club of its approval or disapproval. A licensed or member club is allowed to hold up to two field trials per calendar year.	SECTION 1. A club which wishes to hold a licensed or member field trial must apply to The American Kennel Club on a form which will be supplied on request to clubs that meet the requirements of The American Kennel Club. This application will be referred to the Board of Directors of The American Kennel Club which will consider it and notify the club of its approval or disapproval. A licensed or member club is allowed to hold up to <u>four</u> field trials per calendar year.	This increases the maximum number of trials a club can hold from 2 to 4.
