



IMPORTANT REMINDERS - "Before You ACT"

The red path shown is the ideal path for the videographer. Be sure to video all contacts FROM THE SIDE, and from a distance so the contacts are clearly visible to the reviewer. If using a stationary camera, the evaluator must be able to see all obstacles clearly.

Video 10 sec. prior to and after the conclusion of the run.

HOW IS ACT SCORED?

Any of the below will result non-qualifying (NQ) scores:

1. Handlers carrying or awarding any toys or treats on the course, including before the start or at the finish.
2. For safety reasons, there may not be any tags or attachments on the dog's collar. Dogs may run without collars.
3. A dropped jump bar
4. A missed contact
5. A score less than 85
 Each Wrong Course = 5 faults
 Each Table Fault (dog jumps on & off table) = 5 faults

Refusals & runouts are not scored in ACT 1 or ACT 2.

OTHER NOTES:

Remember to set the Aframe at 5' high.

The table should be set at the same height the dog is jumping.
