

## IMPORTANT REMINDERS - "Before You ACT."

The red path shown is the ideal path for the videographer. Be sure to video all contacts FROM THE SIDE, and from a distance so the contacts are clearly visible to the reviewer. If using a stationary camera, the evaluator must be able to see all obstacles clearly.

Video 10 sec. prior to and after the conclusion of the run.

## **HOW IS ACT SCORED?**

Any of the below will result non-qualifying (NQ) scores:

- 1. Handlers carrying or awarding any toys or treats on the course, including before the start or at the finish.
- For safety reasons, there may not be any tags or attachments on the dog's collar. Dogs may run without collars.
- 3. A dropped jump bar
- 4. A missed contact
- 5. A score less than 85Each Wrong Course = 5 faultsEach Table Fault (dog jumps on & off table) = 5 faults

Refusals & runouts are not scored in ACT 1 or ACT 2.

## **OTHER NOTES:**

Remember to set the Aframe at 5' high.

The table should be set at the same height the dog is jumping.
