Meet Slingshot, the 4 year old Whippet who is trying to beat the Guinness World Record for Dock Diving!

Slingshot, is a 4-year-old Whippet owned, bred, and handled by Rachael Brinkman of Fenton, Michigan. Slingshot is a dock diving champion who has already broken 11 world records with various dock jumping organizations. Having jumped 35 feet multiple times this summer, he already unofficially beat the 31-foot Guinness record.

CAN YOU SPOT THE DIFFERENCES?

The German Shepherd and Belgian Malinois share some similar features but are also two very different dog breeds. Find out more about each breed below and see if you can spot the differences.



The German Shepherd Dog is one of America's most popular **breeds**. It was first bred in Germany to herd sheep but quickly became a police and military dog.

- German Shepherds weigh between 65-90 pounds.
- They are loyal to their family and very smart.
- They love to be active and do well in all kinds of dog sports.



The Belgian Malinois was bred in Belgium to be a **herding** dog and protector of the farm. More recently this breed has been used in police and military work because of their energetic work ethic.

- Belgians weigh between 40-80 pounds.
- They need plenty of physical and mental exercise.
- Their bones are smaller giving them a short, skinny frame which make them excellent runners.


breed: a particular kind of dog

"No Better Friend" by: Robert Weintraub (grades 6 and up)


